

Example questions that we will ask:

1. Will there need to be plumbing roughed in under the slab prior to pouring floors?
  - a. (This will need to be done by a plumber).
2. What sleeves or openings do you need through the concrete wall?
  - a. (Water line, sewer/septic line, HVAC openings, etc.)
3. Will you need a brickledge?
  - a. (If areas of your house are going to be bricked and require a support ledge, what areas?)
4. What location would you like your sump pit?
  - a. (This is required for crawl spaces as well)
5. If desired, what location would you like drains in the basement floor?
  - a. (These drains are connected to the perimeter drains and lead to the sump pit. If PVC is preferred or traps are needed then a plumber would need to take care of them.)
6. Will there be any windows in the concrete walls?
  - a. (If so, we will need rough opening sizes)
7. Did you want to upgrade to the Lifetime Waterproofing Option on your bid sheet?
8. If we are pouring a garage floor for you; would you prefer a sloped floor or a floor with drains?
  - a. (Any specialty drains will need to be installed by a plumber)
9. What are the bearing points or areas needed to support your floor system?
  - a. (This can be provided by the lumber company that you are using)
